Who are we?

We are SARAC. A Sexual Abuse Rape Advice Centre based in Burton on Trent.

We offer confidential support for people in Burton, Lichfield, Tamworth, Uttoxeter, Swadlincote and South Derbyshire who are at risk of, or have experienced sexual abuse/violence or rape at any time in their lives.

How we make a difference in your area

We provide a range of services, including:

- 1-to-1 Specialist Abuse Support and counselling for anyone over 11 years of age who has experienced or is experiencing sexual abuse/violence or rape.
- Specialised Male Abuse Support groups for men to share their experiences of rape/sexual abuse in a safe, anonymous environment.

- A Support Helpline and Signposting for anyone who is struggling and in need of our support.
- Young Persons Education working in colleges and schools to teach our next generations about respect, consent and healthy relationships.
- Help and Guidance for those who may have assisted someone who has experienced sexual assault, including support workers helping those in trauma.
- HR and Workplace Training in which we provide specialist sexual abuse training for staff, and work with HR teams on rewriting policies.

SARAC believes that it is every person's human right to live their life free of violence, and if violence occurs, it is their right to receive compassionate, professional assistance in their recovery.
